Burwell, NE – Governor Pete Ricketts has announced the state of Nebraska is discontinued its Directed Health Measures at the end of the day Monday, May 24, 2021. The Governor also issued a new executive order (EO 21-05) to prohibit masks from being mandated in State of Nebraska code agency office buildings. Governor Ricketts stated, “under this order, State teammates who had been working remotely because of the pandemic will return to in-person work arrangement. As life returns to normal, it’s time to reconnect with one another to make sure we don’t lose the things that make Nebraska great. I encourage Nebraskans to reengage with the relationships and activities that have been disrupted by the coronavirus. Whether it is your place of worship, recreation, or volunteerism, reflect on how you can reconnect with the people you love and the organizations you have served over the years. Together, we can continue to grow the Good Life as we put the pandemic behind us.”
